Initial assessments in maths and English.

How long will it last?

Typical duration: 30 months

How will it be assessed?

The end-point assessment will contain three components:

- ▶ *Knowledge test*
- ▶ *Skills test*
- ▶ *Oral questions*

Qualification gained

- ▶ *Level 2 Functional Skills in Maths and English if appropriate*

Progression to further study

Successful apprentices can progress, if opportunity allows, onto:

- ▶ *Level 3 Diploma in Bricklaying*
